3.2. Purpose of the general-purpose donations for Indigenous Health

- x Upon receipt of directed campaign funds, these are allocated to the relevant cost centre for use in that program.
- x The general-purpose donations wished to be used for Indigenous Health programs are for supporting , Q G L J H Q R X V D Q G philanthodic + H D O W K programs and activities that meet the Indigenous Health and RACS's strategic plan in Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand. Every endeavour is made to use the donations as per the donors wished. If this cannot occur, the funds will be used in similar programs or activities.

3.3. Allocation and use of funds

- a. Funds raised from directed campaigns and allocated into the relevant cost centre can be used as necessary by Indigenous Health.
- b. Liaison and notification with Indigenous Health are required from both the Foundation and RACS Finance to ensure the relevant Indigenous Health Cost Centre is selected for allocation.
