- 3.1.3. The Chair of the New Zealand National Subcommittee of the Board of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery is a permanent observer to the Board of SET.

3.2. Duties and Responsibilities

The BSET is responsible for the regulation and administration of RACS's Surgical Education and Training Programs in Australia and New Zealand and in some regions of Asia. It also determines policy on the assessment of International Medical Graduates (IMG) seeking to practice in Australia, and New Zealand based IMGs seeking fellowship of RACS. IMG Assessment Panels report to the Board of SET.

Specialty Boards report directly to the BSET on their delegated responsibilities as specified in the individual board terms of reference (see Associated Documents). The BSET also advises the Education Board on policy matters relating to Surgical Education and Training.

The duties of individual members of the BSET are:
